Introduction – God establishes symbols to keep us informed and grateful.

I. The Symbols

- Rainbow, circumcision, sacrificial system, feasts, priest garments, temple furnishing and various monuments
- Today: Written Word, Baptism and The Lord's Supper
- First-born is Mine – Exodus 13:1-2; 12-13
- Redeem children and animals for a price

II. Importance of remembering

- We tend to forget:
 - We were lost sinners without hope
 - Salvation depends on God's grace
 - The time we thought God forgot us
 - The promises we made to God and others
- Reminds us of our blessings
 - Lord's Supper – Shed blood/ Body broken
 - Baptism – Died and risen with Christ

III. The Passover – Exodus 12:1-14

- Lamb without blemish
- Four days testing
- Slain and consumed
- Blood applied for freedom

Conclusion – Our new life in Christ becomes a daily monument.
