Introduction – Against the backdrop of a world filled with questions of “why”, God is still the “Who”!

I. A burden – vv. 1:1-4

- Affliction of the righteous
- Prosperity of the ungodly
- Why is God so insensitive?

II. A reason – vv. 1:5-7, 12-14

- God is doing His work
- God uses an evil nation
- Habakkuk questions God: Why use the wicked Chaldeans?

III. A vision given – vv. 2:1

- Standing watch/ anticipation of God’s answer
- The Lord will judge His children – vv. 2:5, 15-20
- The Lord has a future purpose – 2:14; Isaiah 11:9-11;  
Hebrews 10:37-38
- The Lord only saves by faith – v. 2:4; Romans 1:16-17;  
Galatians 3:11-14

Conclusion - Hope not in what God can do for us but hope in the God of our salvation – v. 3:18-19
