  - Yadah - Raise hands - Psalm 138:1
  - Barak - Bowing or kneeling - Psalm 103:1
  - Zamar - Loud music - Psalm 150:3-5
  - Shabach - Shout or holler - Psalm 63:3-4
  - Towdah - Hands lifted receptively - Psalm 50:23
  - Tehilah - Exuberant singing - Psalm 34:1

### III. Who is **FIRST**?

- God wants to be - Exodus 20:3; Mark 12:30
- Hidden love? - Psalm 84:10; Heart, soul, mind and strength
